Maths	<p>Each day students will be set a MathsWatch task which will consist of a mixed revision starter followed by a new topic.</p> <p><u>They should watch the videos to help them before completing the tasks</u> and if they are still stuck should contact their class teacher. We expect these to be completed with each student getting 80% or more correct. The pod work and questions will be checked daily.

Summer term weeks 4-7

Students will revise the play **An Inspector Calls** (they did this in class at start of Y10, Last September).

Again, the work will consist of watching pods, answering questions and completing work in their revision booklet which will be emailed to them.
