Subject: MFL

STATEMENT OF INTENT

Learning a foreign language is a liberation from insularity and provides an opening to other cultures, allowing students to become citizens of the world, thus equipping them to study and work in other countries. Our aim is to create engaged, inquisitive and confident linguists that can communicate effectively in real-life situations but also have a solid foundation of grammar that will open the door to studying languages at KS4. Encouraging our students to identify with languages and valuing different styles of communication will help them develop a mindset that prizes academic progress too. Studies have shown that pupils who think themselves as good at languages outperform their peers not only in MFL, but also in other subjects.

IMPLEMENTATION

MFL teaching and learning should enable pupils to express their ideas and thoughts in another language and to understand and respond to its speakers, both in speech and in writing. It should also provide opportunities for them to communicate for practical purposes, learn new ways of thinking and enjoy great literature and film in the original language. We teach a variety of topics which tie-in with the five GCSE themes: identity and culture; school; local area, holiday and travel; future aspirations and international and global dimension.

Pupils are taught to:

Grammar and vocabulary

- identify and use tenses or other structures which convey the present, past, and future as appropriate to Spanish or French
- use and manipulate a variety of key grammatical structures and patterns
- develop and use a wide-ranging and deepening vocabulary that goes beyond their immediate needs and interests, including idiomatic expressions, allowing them to give and justify opinions and take part in discussion about wider issues
- use accurate grammar, spelling and pronunciation

Linguistic competence

- listen to a variety of forms of spoken language to obtain information and respond appropriately
- transcribe words and short sentences that they hear with increasing accuracy
- initiate and develop conversations, coping with unfamiliar language and unexpected responses
- express and develop ideas clearly and with increasing accuracy, both orally and in writing
- speak coherently and confidently, with increasingly accurate pronunciation
- read and show comprehension of original and adapted materials from a range of different sources, understanding the purpose, important ideas and details, and provide an accurate English translation of short, suitable material
- write prose using an increasingly wide range of grammar and vocabulary, write creatively to express their own ideas and opinions, and translate short written texts accurately from or into the foreign language
